MY CLEAN NEIGHBORHOOD

Environmental sanitation is a major public health issue in India and a part of the sustainable development goals throughout the world. As a part of introspection and taking responsibility for our surroundings. IMPAR conducted a cleanliness and awareness drive on 28.06.2020.

Our public places, mosques and temples are strewn with garbage, but rather than cleaning these spaces we have been closing our eyes and thinking it is someone else's responsibility to clean. To counter this mindset, IMPAR launched cleanliness drive and the awareness program to take up the responsibility of sanitation, raise awareness about hygiene and cleanliness in our lives and most importantly figuring out long term sustainable strategies towards cleanliness.

The awareness program and campaign was done in Old Delhi and the volunteers covered the area around Meena Bazar-lama Masiid, Hai Manzil, Jain Mandir Gauri Shankar Mandir, Shishgani Gurudwara and Central Baptist Church.

The awareness campaign highlighted the importance of sanitation and hygiene especially through the COVID 19 crisis. 

IMPAR GLOBAL ZAKAT FUND ACCOUNT

Given the positive change that zakat funds can bring about in the socio-economic conditions of the poor families, IMPAR has created Zakat Fund Account to be supervised by a 25 Members Global Zakat Advisory Board for Sharia compliant effective and transparent use. In the current pandemic situation, IMPAR is implementing an 11 Point Covid Response Action Plan to help in emergency medical aid, feeding at hospitals, burial support and documentation, creating district corona response units, distributing covid home care kits, and for livelihood support to the affected families.

GENERAL DONATION AND CHARITY ACCOUNT

We have few ongoing programs to be funded by general donations as IMPAR is implementing a comprehensive action plan to bring about a positive change in the community's current educational and socio-economic-political status.
