COMMUNICATION WITH THE CONCERNED AUTHORITIES


In its endeavor to establish channels of communication and engage with the administration and political leadership of the country, IMPAR wrote various letters of concern.

- 2. RESEARCH AND PROJECTS

- ➤ A **Detailed Project Plan** has been developed to partner with Madarsa for improving the quality of education delivery and facilitating NIOS certification for its students and at the same time help these Madarsa become operationally self-reliant within 5 years of IMPAR interventions. As part of the project, training will be provided to teachers on Knowledge, Skill, and Behavior, and Counselling of students and parents will be done at Madarsa.
- ➤ A proposal for **IMPAR Community Information & Facilitation Center** has been prepared with the goals to provide information on different welfare programs, policies, procedures, capacity building. This center will also encourage entrepreneurship among the youth and women by facilitating up-skilling, reskilling, knowledge sharing and preparation of different documents or forms for starting a business venture.
- ➤ A research study being conducted by IMPAR to assess the "Impact of COVID 19 on Educational Institutions". The proposed study has been planned to assess the impact of COVID-19 on three important stakeholders of schools/institutions, Students, Teachers and Management. Separate questionnaire for each stakeholder is developed, which focuses on educational, economic, health, social and psychological impact of COVID-19.






WEBINARS HELD


IMPAR writes to the Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh raising concern against the attack on Mosque in Madhya Pradesh

On Tuesday December 29%, 2020, large groups of armed persons have reportedly attacked the people, properties, and place of worship of Muslims community at some places, including Dorana utilage near Mandsour city in Madhya Pradesh. The incident took place while some right-wing members were taking out a rally to create awareness about a fund-collection campaign for the proposed Ram temple at Ayodhya. It is also reported that instead of providing the relief and security to the victims, who are predominately from Muslim community, the local administration had acted against them while the actual culprits had gone scot free. This has created a sense of insecurity, fear, and unrest amongst the members of Muslim community in the affected areas and beyond. Dr. MJ Khan, President, Indian Muslims for Progress and Reforms (IMPAR) wrote to Shri Shivraj (Chauhanji, Honourable Chief Minister, Madhya Pradesh about the same seeking his intervention to take stringent action against the actual perpetutor of violence who disturbed the inter-community harmony and to provide immediate relief to the actual victims by releasing the innocent people from the custody and provide just compensation for the losses suffered by the victims.




On December 25th, 2020, IMPAR greeted the citizens on the birth anniversary of Atal Bihari Vajpayee, marked as Good Governance Day.
