The delegation later visited the Hon'ble Union Minister of Minority Affairs, Mukhtar Abbas Naqvi at his residence and held detailed discussions on various programs and policies and emphasised the need for enhancing access to schemes and promoting Startups and entrepreneurship among the youth. The Minister shared in detail the work of the Ministry and new initiatives, especially in promoting education. He mentioned about the success of Hunar Haats and asked the delegation to make a detailed presentation to the Ministry.

IMPAR DELEGATION MEETING WITH RAJYA SABHA MP



The delegation later met the Hon'ble Rajya Sabha MP, Dr. Ashok Bajpai, who greatly appreciated the working of IMPAR and offered his full support. He also informed that Muslims access to certain welfare schemes in States like UP is 31% and asked IMPAR to work on the ground to further accelerate the same. Issues of social concerns and police and security related were also raised.

IMPAR DELEGATION MEETING WITH SHREE PRAKASH JAVADEKAR, MINISTER OF INFORMATION & BROADCASTING



On 24th February 2021, as part of policy advocacy and governmental engagement program, four-member IMPAR delegation, comprised of Steering Committee members, Mr Shahid Siddiqui, Dr MJ Khan, Mr Shamsheer Siddiqui and Mr Nesar Ahmed called on the Union Minister of Environment, Industry and I&B, Mr Prakash Javadekar and thanked him for his support and the Ministry of I&B issuing an advisory to media during the peak of Corona Jihad, which had created extremely hateful anti-Muslim environment. The delegation also discussed the Muslim community engagement with the media and the Government. He has agreed to join a zoom meeting to interact with the community on media and education subjects. In his previous tenure, Mr Javadekar was the Minister of HRD.

IMPAR DELEGATION MEETING WITH SHRI BHUPENDRA YADAV- , MP AND CHAIRMAN, PARLIAMENTARY SELECT COMMITTEE, AND ALSO CHAIRMAN OF PUBLIC GRIEVANCES COMMITTEE, RAJYA SABHA



IMPAR delegation called on Sh. Bhupendra Yadav, MP and Chairman, Parliamentary Select Committee, and also Chairman of Public Grievances Committee, Rajya Sabha. The delegation presented before him the concerns of the community and various issues faced by it from the sense of discrimination to injustice and insecurity and lack of adequate representation in Government. Specific issues related to CAA and UAPA and NE Riots were also discussed. He shared the concerns and promised to discuss them within the party and with the Home Ministry. Mr Yadav is also the party general secretary.

IMPAR STEERING COMMITTEE MEETING



On 5th March 2021, IMPAR Steering Committee yesterday had its first meeting in physical format in New Delhi since its formation on April 10, 2020. Major recommendations included:

1. IMPAR to function as an apex think tank and advocacy forum for strategic planning and coordinated actions. And act as apex monitoring, research and response centre.
2. Education to be promoted as the movement by IMPAR coordinating with all India minority educational institutions and holding a global conference.
3. To address issues, connecting to opportunities and promoting leaderships, IMPAR would host four global conferences on 1. Youth 2. Business 3. Policies, besides 4. education. IMPAR would also host a women leadership conference on 8 March on Women's Day in Delhi and also in various cities and districts.
4. Dialogues with key stakeholders, including Central and State Governments, political leaderships, intellectuals, media and corporate bodies, including FICCI, Assocham and CII to be organised.

5. To promote micro-enterprises with credit support the idea of creating an NBFC was mooted. Linking community youth with various government schemes and opportunities through IMPAR District Councils was stressed.
6. Establishing a national legal network and emergency response team (ERT) comprised of prominent lawyers at district, state and national level to provide legal support and emergency support in urgent matters was also emphasised with the suggestion to start a toll-free number.
7. With a unanimous view it was agreed that IMPAR must streamline its working and focus on few agenda to make a credible difference. Policy and perception management at the national level, and economic opportunities and education movement at the grassroots level should be focused on.


Aayushman Bharat Camp at Bhopal, MP





International Women's Day






On 3rd March 2021 IMPAR Celebrated World Wildlife Day
