


MEETING OF IMPAR STEERING COMMITTEE

IMPAR ADVISORY GROUP FIRST MEETING WAS HELD, JOINED BY 9 MEMBERS:

The discussions focussed on organising community response to the corona crisis. All other agendas were set aside for future meetings.

Following decisions were taken:

- 1. IMPAR Langer was organised with 1,000 packets distributed at 5 different locations outside major hospitals in Delhi. Dargah Ajmer will organise under the Impar banner in addition to this. (Estimated budget Rs 7.50 lacs Rs. 5.50 lacs were already committed by 5 members.
- **2.** IMPAR Awareness and Sanitation Drive was launched at public places in Delhi by volunteers in IMPAR T-shirts. spray of sanitisers and educating people on covid safety protocols.
- **3.** Letter to Rajasthan CM on Dargah Ajmer offering its facilities for setting up covid care centre. Also letters were sent to all CMs on the community facilities to be offered for the same.
- **4.** Exploring with Haj committees if Haj House could be offered for covid care units and also Khanqah, Madarsa and Masjids under ASI for the same purpose.
- **5.** To Check with Eidgah committees if the grounds could be offered for govt creating covid facilities.
- **6.** Checking with the community institutions if they could offer facilities for Government setting up vaccination centres. Also checking with Govt authorities about the need and protocols for the same.
- **7.** Formed a panel of doctors for consultation support to covid patients.
- **8.** Putting up impar helpline numbers at major hospitals in Delhi and other cities for burial support. Also coordinated with waqf boards and kabristan committees to appeal them for recycling of grounds to accommodate unprecedented increase in load.
- **9.** Condolence messages sent to public figures and prominent persons who died of corona in recent days.
- **10.** Launched IMPAR Zakat Portal, managed by 11 member committee, for generating funds to help the needy and also fund the covid work as listed above.



















SANITATION DRIVE






IMPAR LIVELIHOOD PROGRAM

IMPAR writes to PM, urges to mediate between Israel and Palestine conflict

New Delhi, May 16: Indian Muslims for Progress and Reforms (IM-PAR) writes to Prime Minister Narendra Modi and the Minister of External Affairs Subrahmanyam Jaishankar to influence both Israel and Palestine to immediately end the conflict, which poses a serious risk to engulf a full-scale war in the region.

The eruption of violence in East Jerusalem and in other parts of Palestine and Gaza have caused deep pain and anguish to the people the world over. The forceful entry of Israeli security forces in the Al Aqsa mosque and attempt to evict Palestinian families from their



Air attacks on Gaza by Israel Defense Forces resulted in tragic loss of innocent human lives.

homes is distressing and raised grave concern in India and around the world, IMPAR said in a letter addressed to PM.

The safety, security, and dignity of the Palestine people are routinely trampled by Israel for decades. Palestinian and Arab Israeli people have a right to live with dignity and security as much

as the Jewish people of Israel, said IMPAR.

During these times, India can play a vital role by leveraging its influence and relations and reach out to both the State of Israel as well as Palestine and urge them to cease the hostilities and attacks from both sides immediately, IMPAR appealed to the Government.
