
EVENTS:

Interactive Webinar on "The Effect of Sir Syed's Transnational Reformist Approach on Contemporary Learning"

On 17 October 202, an online program was conducted on the birth anniversary of Sir Syed Ahmad Khan-Founder of AMU- and the following points were discussed by the speakers about his life and works:

Mr Khalid Ansari, Executive Director, IMPAR commenced the program and welcomed all members. Remembering Sir Syed Ahmad Khan on his birth anniversary, Mr Khalid Ansari stated that Sir Syed was a scholar of great repute; he was an intellectual, educationist, political activist, journalist, theologian, social reformer, and a key organizer in shaping the career path of Indian Muslims in the 19th century in India. His farsighted views about Indian Muslims and other oppressed classes established him as the foremost voice of the nation among his contemporaries. Sir Syed was the torchbearer of enlightenment and wisdom. From establishing Muhammadan Anglo-Oriental College, Scientific Society in Aligarh, to editing Tehzeeb-ul-Akhlaq, Sir Syed played a major role in saving his community from complete cultural and intellectual decay. His views were well ahead of his times. His goal was to combine Islamic education with the western education system. In this endeavour, he fought a tireless battle against outdated practices and brought into the curriculums what was futuristic. Mr Khalid Ansari then invited other speakers to go ahead with the proceedings. Major personalities present in the program were the following;


A Letter was written to Hon'ble Chief Minister Government of Tripura, and Director General of Police, Tripura against Spate of Crime in Tripura

इम्पार ने बांग्लादेश में दशहरे के अवसर पर भक्तों पर हमले की निंदा की

नई दिल्ली (New Delhi) . बांग्लादेश की प्रधानमंत्री शेख हसीना की चेतावनी को दरिकनार करते हुए भीड़ ने बांग्लादेश के नोआखली में इस्कॉन मंदिर में भक्तों पर हिंसक हमला किया और दशहरा पर 15 अक्टूबर, 2021 (शुक्रवार) को मंदिर परिसर को क्षितिग्रस्त कर दिया और एक श्रद्धालु की हालत चोट लगने से नाजुक पाई गई. यह हमला बांग्लादेश की प्रधान मंत्री शेख हसीना द्वारा हिंदू मंदिरों पर हमला करने वालों को पहचान कर उन्हें दंडित करने के बयान देने के कुछ घंटों बाद किया गया. यह बयान बांग्लादेश की प्रधान मंत्री द्वारा द्वारा 14 अक्टूबर, 2021 (गुरुवार) को दुर्गा पूजा समारोह के दौरान दिया गया था जब कुछ अज्ञात उपव्रवियों द्वारा हिंदू मंदिरों पर एक और हमले की निंदा कर रही थी, जिसमें तीन की मौत हो गई और बाद में हुए दंगे में कई अन्य घायल हो गए. हालांकि बांग्लादेश की प्रधान मंत्री शेख हसीना ने दोषियों को दंडित करने का वादा किया है, लेकिन भीड़ ने उनकी बातों पर ध्यान नहीं दिया और हमले को जारी रखा. इम्पार निर्दोष नागरिकों की हत्या की निंदा करता है. IMPAR बांग्लादेश सरकार से अल्पसंख्यक समुदायों की सुरक्षा सुनिश्चित करने और अपराधियों को न्याय दिलाने का आह्वान करता है. इम्पार सकज अनासिर तत्वों को एक सलाह भी देना चाहता है कि यदि उनकी हरकतें धार्मिक कट्टरता से प्रेरित हैं, तो उन्हें यह समझना चाहिए कि उनके कृत्य सबसे गैर-इस्लामी हैं और इससे इस्लाम की बदनामी ही होगी. हम चाहते हैं कि तेजी से बढ़ती अर्थव्यवस्था के रूप में बांग्लादेश को अपनी सर्वांगीण प्रगति के लिए सांप्रदायिक सद्भाव सुनिश्चित करना चाहिए और जिस के लिए एक सिहष्णु समाज के रूप में वैश्विक स्वीकृति में वृद्धि एक पूर्व-आवश्यकता है. कि बांग्लादेश सरकार अपने सख्त उपायों के माध्यम से अपने कट्टरपंथी तत्वों को स्पष्ट रूप से संदेश देने में सक्षम है.

IMPAR pays its rich tribute to Ashfaqullah Khan on his birth anniversary

On October 22, 2021, the noted newspaper from Lucknow/Delhi gave space to IMPAR news. The newspaper stated that IMPAR has paid a respectful homage to Ashfaqullah Khan -one of the greatest Freedom Fighters of the Indian Freedom Struggle- on his 121st birth anniversary i.e. 22 October.



Ashfaqulla Khan was born on 22 October 1900, in a wealthy landlord family in Shahjahanpur, Uttar Pradesh. He was a revolutionary intellectual and an idealistic young man who sacrificed his life for the country. In 1920, Mahatma Gandhi had launched his Non-Cooperation Movement against British rule in India but withdrew the agitation due to the Chauri Chaura incident in 1922. At that point, Ashfaqulla Khan and many

other young people were disheartened and decided to form an organization with like-minded freedom fighters which resulted in the formation of Hindustan Republican Association. On 9 August 1925, Khan along with other members tried to loot a train carrying British government money traveling from Shahjahanpur to Lucknow. Several revolutionaries boarded the train at Hardoi and when it halted at Kakori they barged into the guard's cabin to pull off the treasury box, but in the skirmish, they accidentally shot an innocent passenger and thereby had to abandon their heist and run away.

Ashfaqulla Khan remained untraceable for a long time but was eventually betrayed by a friend who notified the police about his whereabouts. Khan was caught on the morning of 17 July 1926 and was detained in the Faizabad jail, His brother Riasat Ullah Khan was his legal counsel but the case for the Kakori dacoity was concluded by awarding death sentence to the revolutionary and he was hanged on December 19, 1927, along with Bismil and Roshan Singh (all in different prisons), for their role in the Kakori train robbery. This courageous man who was also a poet deserves to be remembered as a revolutionary intellectual who also tried to give shape to the larger revolutionary movement of Independence. IMPAR pays its rich tribute to Ashfaqullah Khan on his birth anniversary for the unforgettable services he rendered to the nation.

शमी देश तुम्हारे साथ खड़ा है, अगले मैच में अपना कमाल दिखा दो: IMPAR

नई दिल्लीः भारत-पाकिस्तान टी 20 मैच में भारत की हार के बाद भारतीय गेंदबाज़ मोहम्मद शमी को ट्विटर व अन्य सोशल मीडिया प्लेटफार्म पर ट्रोल किया गया, उन्हें गलियां दी गयी, पाकिस्तान समर्थक कहा गया। इसपर IMPAR (Indian Muslim For Progress And Reforms) ने एक सार्वजनिक पत्र लिख कर मोहम्मद शमी का पक्ष लिया। और देश में चल रहे नफरती अभियान को रोकने की अपील की।

IMPAR का पत्र निम्नलिखित है-

शाबाश मोहम्मद शमी :-

राष्ट्रीय कैप पहन कर राष्ट्र सेवा करना एक क्रिकेटर के लिए सबसे बड़ी उपलब्धि होती है। और जब आपकी बेटी ICU में भर्ती हो, उस समय देश के लिए गेंदबाज़ी करना एक ऐसी चुनौती है जिसे केवल एक सच्चा चैंपियन ही पूरी कर सकता है।

भारतीय क्रिकेट टीम के तेज़ गैंदबाज़ मोहम्मद शमी एक ऐसे चैंपियन हैं, जो क्रिकेट के सभी प्रारूपों में शीर्ष पर हैं। उनकी रैंकिंग अंतर्राष्ट्रीय क्रिकेट में टॉप 10 पर है। इस तरह के एक प्रभावशाली रिकॉर्ड के साथ मोहम्मद शमी 24 अक्टूबर रविवार को पाकिस्तान के खिलाफ टी 20 वर्ल्ड कप मैच खेलने दुबई गए। इस मैच के दौरान किसी भी भारतीय गेंदबाज़ ने पाकिस्तान के दोनों सलामी बल्लेबाज़ों के खिलाफ कोई खास प्रदर्शन नहीं किया। न ही बुमराह की यॉर्कर ने कोई कमाल दिखाया, जडेजा भी नाकाम ही रहे, स्पिनर चकर्वर्ती और भुवनेश्वर भी सिर्फ अपनी जान ही बचाते हुए नज़र आए। इसी प्रकार बाकि खिलाडियों की तरह मोहम्मद शमी का प्रदर्शन भी खराब ही रहा, उन्होंने 4 ओवर में 43 रन दिए, जिनमें से 15 रन आखिर ओवर में उस समय दिए जब पाकिस्तान के बल्लेबाज़ पूरी फॉर्म में थे और किसी भी तरह उनकी जीत निश्चित ही समझी जा रही थी।

यही हाल भारतीय बल्लेबाज़ों का भी रहा, केवल भारतीय कप्तान विराट कोहली ही किसी तरह से अर्धशतक बनाने में कामयाब रहे, बाकि पूरी टीम के बल्लेबाज़ 100 रन भी पुरे नहीं बना पाए। हकीकत यह है कि क्रिकेट में इस तरह की चीज़े होना स्वाभाविक है। कभी किसी खिलाड़ा का दिन अच्छा नहीं होता तो कभी पूरी ही टीम फॉर्म से बाहर होती है, यही भारतीय टीम के साथ 24 अक्टूबर के मैच में हुआ था।

फिर भी, केवल मोहम्मद शमी को ही ट्विटर पर ट्रोल किया गया, जो कि केवल दुखद ही नहीं, बल्कि कथित रूप से पढ़े-लिखे लोगों के एक वर्ग के जहरीलेपन और बेशर्मी का सबूत भी है, यह लोग एक खिलाड़ी को उसके रिकॉर्ड और उपलब्धियों से नहीं बल्कि उसके नाम और धर्म से पहचानते हैं। यह वर्ग आस्था के संरक्षक के रूप में कार्य करने का दिखावा करता है, लेकिन हकीकत में यह नैतिक रूप से भ्रष्ट और घृणित लोग हैं।

मोहम्मद शमी की इस विशेष मैच में भूमिका के कारण उन्हें गालियां देना, उनके खिलाफ अभियान चलाना और उनके पाकिस्तान समर्थक बताना देश में चल रहे घटिया सामाजिक, सांस्कारिक और राजनितिक परिदृश्य का ही एक हिस्सा है।

हम IMPAR के लोग यह समझने में नाकामयाब हैं कि, आखिर देश में अल्पसंख्यक समुदाय खासकर मुसलमानों के खिलाफ क्यों ज़हर घोला जा रहा है? क्यों एक छोटी सी बात को हमलों और गलियों का कारण बना दिया जाता है? क्या इसका कारण मुस्लिम समुदाय का एक खास पार्टी को वोट न देना है? यह हालत जो देश में तथाकथिक पढ़े-लिखे जाहिल लोगों ने अपने ज़हरीले ज़हन से पैदा कर दिए हैं, वह शायद फिर से बहाल न हो पाएं, बल्कि उनके द्वारा फैलाए ज़हर से देश में नफरत और साम्प्रदायिकता और अधिक बढ़ रही है।

महरबानी करके इस नफरती समाज के निर्माण को रोक दीजिए इससे पहले कि देर हो जाए। एक राजनितिक विचारधारा की भिक्त ने आज पढ़े-लिखे समाज को एक ऐसे जाहिल समाज में बदल दिया है, जो लोगों को उनके नाम और धर्म के आधार पर बांटने और नफरत फैलाने का काम कर रहा है, बडा ही अफसोसजनक काम है।

मोहम्मद शमी, IMPAR और पूरा देश तुम्हारे साथ खड़ा है। लगे रहो और अगले मैच में अपना कमाल दिखा दो।

NCB Case involving Aryan Khan and Arbaaz Merchant October 11, 2021

It has been five days since the raid was conducted by officials of the Narcotics Control Bureau on a cruise liner where 8 persons were reportedly found possessing contraband drugs and taken into custody. Out of these 8 persons, the names of Aryan Khan and Arbaaz Merchant are being consistently highlighted by the media and non-bonafide characters only because their fathers are celebrities belonging to a minority community. Notwithstanding, the media has not yet checked or disclosed the antecedents of the remaining 6 persons caught in the net.

IMPAR takes strong exception to the gross anomaly in selectively and impartially targeting celebrities just to garner cheap publicity, while the families of Arbaaz Merchant and Aryan Khan are paying a heavy price of being celebrities. If the two have committed a crime in reportedly possessing a very small quantity of contraband substance, then the law should take the due course for a fair trial. However, the fairness of the trial and the procedure adopted by NCB is highly suspect because along with the officials of NCB, two nonofficials have been seen in the videos that have gone viral, escorting Aryan and Arbaaz to the NCB office. The presence of these two non-officials raises doubts on the conduct of NCB and the procedure adopted by its officials because of these reasons: (1) The two non-officials are K.P Gosavi, a businessman, and Manish Bhanushali, a member of BJP as he has been photographed hobnobbing with BJP leaders and visiting their offices. (2) NCB's claim that independent witnesses accompany NCB officials during raids to stand as witnesses to record the Panchnama. Now the question is why persons affiliated with a particular party were considered fit to act as Panchas? A political representative cannot be considered independent of pre-existing political leanings. (3) Is it judicious and prudent to take along persons having political affiliation while conducting an undercover operation? (4) Is it not a violation of the procedure under NDPS Act when Panchas escorts a raiding party and takes and circulates selfies for ungainly publicity while the officials and police are sidelined? The role of Panchas is limited to recollecting and narrating the turn of events; they do not have the authority to forcibly escort those who are caught in such an operation. The pre and postoperation smacks of immaturity and unprofessionalism.

In this context, senior NCP leader and Cabinet Minister in Maharashtra Govt., Mr Nawab Malik, held a press conference on Oct. 6 2021 where he raised questions regarding the suspicious role of Manish Bhanushali who took selfies with Aryan Khan when he was in NCB custody. Mr Malik also alleged Bhanushali is a BJP office-nearer.

For the reasons given above, this raid on the cruise liner is turning out to be a staged show to gain political mileage. In addition, this case has turned into yet another episode of targeting and maligning members of the minority community. IMPAR implores the Central and State Governments and the media to desist selective targeting, and immediately remove K.P Gosavi and Manish Bhanushali from further proceedings in this case so that a fair and judicious trial could take place. IMPAR also humbly seeks an unbiased investigation of the role played by Aryan Khan and others.

Keeping aside the warning of Bangladesh's Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina, a mob violently attacked devotees on Dussehra at the ISKCON temple in Noakhali, Bangladesh and damaged the temple premises on October 15, 2021 (Friday). Wherein, the temple had suffered damage and the condition of one devotee was found to be critical. This attack has come a few hours after Bangladesh Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina assured that those who attacked Hindu temples will be hunted down and punished. This statement was given by the Prime Minister of Bangladesh while she was condemning another attack on Hindu temples by some unidentified miscreants during Durga Puja celebrations on October 14, 2021 (Thursday), killing three and injuring many others in the riot that ensued. Although the Bangladesh PM Sheikh Hasina has promised to punish the culprits, the mob appeared to pay no heed to her words and carried on with the attack.

IMPAR condemns the killing of innocent civilians. IMPAR calls upon the Bangladesh Government to ensure the safety of the minority communities and bring the perpetrators to justice.

IMPAR Press Release in Support of Mohammad Shami October 29, 2021

Bravo Mohammad Shami!

Serving the nation while donning the national cap is the biggest achievement for a cricketer. And delivering the best for the nation while the daughter is battling in ICU is a real challenge that only a champion takes head-on. The fast bowler of the Indian cricket team, Mohammad Shami, is the champion who is among the leading wicket-takers in all formats of the game. His ranking among the international cricketers is also within the top ten. With such an impressive record, Mohd. Shami went to play the T-20 match against an untested team of Pakistan in Dubai on Sunday 24th October. As things turned out, none of the bowlers made an impression on the two opening batsmen of Pakistan. Jasprit Bumrah's yorkers were easily negotiated, Ravindra Jadeja was clueless, a newly found spinner, Chakravarthy could not produce his mystery ball, and Bhuvaneshwar had to bowl wide outside the stumps to avoid getting battered. The fifth bowler, Shami, gave away 43 runs- 15 of them in the last over that he bowled. As far as batting is concerned, only Virat Kohli managed to cross half a century, while others failed and altogether managed less than 100 runs. Such things happen in cricket. Sometimes a player has an off-day, and sometimes the entire team is off-colour, which was the case of the Indian cricket team last Sunday. As such, all but one contributed to losing the match. Yet only Mohammad Shami was singled out for getting trolled on Twitter, which is not a tragedy but a shameless turnaround of a section of supposedly educated people getting tarnished by venomous propaganda that distinguishes a person not by his records and achievements but by the name that he carries. This section pretends to act as the guardians of the faith, but their foul acts are of morally depraved and disgusting people. Looking at Mohammad Shami's role in this particular match and the abuses, chants, and charges of being pro-Pakistan is all a small part of a bigger narrative that is going on currently in the social, cultural, and political arena within the country. 


DUSSEHRA

The Missile Man of India

Avul Pakir Jainulabdeen Abdul Kalam was the 11th President of the Republic of India and served his term from 2002 to 2007. Abdul Kalam was born on 15th October 1931 in Rameswaram, Tamil Nadu, in a family who were boatmen. From a young age, he had an interest in scholarly pursuits, and to meet the demands of his studies he sold newspapers as his family earnings had depleted over the years. He did his schooling at Schwartz Higher Secondary School, Ramanathapuram, and then went on to join St Joseph's College, Tiruchirapalli from where he graduated in physics in 1954. Then, in 1955, he moved over to Madras Institute of Technology to study aerospace.

A.P.J Abdul Kalam graduated from M.I.T in 1960 and then joined Defence and Research Development Organisation in its Aeronautical Development Establishment as a scientist. But for a long time, Abdul Kalam was not satisfied with his choice of job. Fortunately, he was also associated with INSCOPAR where he got acquainted with the renowned space scientist, Vikram Sarabhai. In 1969, he was transferred to ISRO- Indian Space Research Organisation where he was the Project Director of India's first Satellite Launch Vehicle which successfully deployed the Rohini Satellite in July 1980. Thereafter, Abdul Kalam went from strength to more strength till he became the Chief Scientific Adviser to the Prime Minister and Secretary of DRDO. It was during this period that the Pokhran II nuclear test was conducted in which he played a proactive role.

In 2002, Abdul Kalam won the presidential election with a massive majority of the electoral votes as the BJP, INC, and SP parties extended their support to him. He moved to the Rashtrapati Bhawan on 25th July 2002 after being sworn in as the 11th President of the Republic of India. He was the first scientist and a bachelor to occupy the president's palace. A.P.J Abdul Kalam was also the third president to be honoured with Bharat Ratna, the highest civilian honour of India. He was fondly called the 'People's President', and 'The Missile Man'.

THE LAST PROPHET

The crimson ball of fire sank beyond the dunes into the sea that turns fluorescent in myriad colours turning kaleidoscopic with every passing minute. The hills display the last embers of a scorching flame, as some caravans pass through the crest of a pass between Akhshaban ranges that leads from Yathreb to the valley of Mecca. It was evident from the colourful trappings the camels adorn that these were not trading convoys.

In a courtyard that spreads wide, Arab chieftains in smocks and contrasting sashes tied in knots, gather together around a blazing fire rising in spirals. There are over two hundred guests from the tribal Sheikhs to the nomad Bedouins, from tradesmen to preachers and poets. Moving among them is the formidable figure of the 70 years old host, Abdul Muttalib, who heads the clan of Banu Hashim and is the custodian of the House of Allah, known as Kaaba. Today, Abdul Muttalib is all smiles. As he leisurely moves between the crowd attending to the needs of his guests, he jests, laughs, and partakes in the merriment.

"I have named him Muhammad," replies Abdul Muttalib to the Sheikh who asked him about the little boy in the arms of a portly slave woman. Others were ear to these words and they pose, "Why Muhammad? Why not a name from your illustrious family?" They knew that the grandfather traced his descent from Hashim to Kalib, and from Adnan to Ismail and Abraham. "I did so," says Abdul Muttalib, "with the wish that my grandson would be praised by God in heaven and on earth by men".

In the Arabian Peninsula, like other continents too, special days were remembered by connecting them with an extraordinary event. So, today was one of those days in the Year of the Elephant, the month was Rabiul Awwal of the Arabic Calendar, that, the latter-day biographers concurred to be the month of April 1451 years ago.

The week-old boy is Muhammad bin Abdullah bin Abdul Muttalib, about whom it is said in the Quran (33:56) "God and His Angels send blessings on the Prophet, O you who believe! Send blessings on him, and salute him with all respect." The name, Muhammad, means 'one who is worthy of praise.' And about him, the learned Christian monk, Bahirah, had told the boy's uncle, Abu Talib, "He is the master of all humans, God will send him with a message." Bahirah had said this after he had seen the apple-like seal of Prophethood below the boy's shoulder. Twenty-eight years from thence, and forty years after Muhammad's birth, Waraqah bin Naufil, a cousin of his wife, Khadijah, who was also a Christian monk said to Muhammad and his wife, "By He who holds Waraqah's soul, it is the sublime Namus" (To whom the Angel brings the Revelation). The great spirit that had come to Moses has now come to you." Mention of his characteristics are also to be found in the Vedas- 'Nirashan's one terrestrial name would be Muhammad (Athur Ved: 3-127-20); Muhammad would be praised, and he would be loved by all (Rig Ved: 1-13-3); Muhammad would be given the Divine knowledge (Rig Ved Sanhata: 3-13-1); Muhammad would emancipate people from sins (Rig Ved: 4-106-1); He would bring about a revolution in the society and have the vices eliminated (Bhagwat Puran: 12-2-12).'

There is no end to study and write about a man whose life and achievements are in historical records to the minutest of details, so here I try to enumerate what he said and practiced during his life. What follows are the traditions narrated by the wives, companions, and biographers of the authentic sayings and practices of Muhammad (May peace and blessings be upon him).

Mecca was conquered by Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) in January 630 A.D eight years after he was compelled to migrate from there. When his army of 10,000 marched in with no fanfare, beating of drums, or bursting of crackers but with heads bowed in gratitude to God, the common questions of the hostile Quraish was, 'How they thought he was going to deal with the conquered'. At that point, the Prophet recited the verse that punctuates the story of Joseph (Yusuf A.S):

"This day let no reproach be (cast) on you: God will forgive, and He is the Most Merciful of those who show mercy" (Q: 12:92).

Then Muhammad said one sentence, "Today there is no blame on you, there will be no retribution; go, all of you are free". He even let the Quraish keep the properties that they had grabbed after the Muslims had migrated from Mecca, and also allowed them to retain their traditional posts and portfolios. When he had become the absolute sovereign of the Arabian Peninsula, he enjoyed no special privileges. He never walked ahead of others like a dignitary, neither did he allow a seat reserved for him when attending a meeting, but would sit wherever he found a place. "I am a man like you," he had said, "I eat food like you and I also sit when I am tired...like you". His house had just a few essentials like a palm-leaf mat, jugs, blankets, and the family seldom had grains that would last more than three days. When he died, all he left behind was the simple dictum, 'We prophets have no heirs, whatever we leave behind is to be given in alms.'

Well before Prophethood was bestowed upon him, Muhammad never got distracted to allow anything to mar the reputation of 'al Amin' that he had earned. He had always led a life far away from vice and immorality and found pleasure in contemplation rather than in music and merry-making. He spoke less and listened more, and was more inclined to participate in the serious talk, though he often shared a joke. Whoever came in contact with him was deeply impressed; whoever had something to do with him, loved him. Often his companions and acquaintances would come to him to dispel doubts on human nature and spirituality. Once he had advised a seeker of guidance, "By He who holds my soul in His hands, if you were able to remain in the spiritual state that you feel in my company and remember God permanently, the angels would shake your hands in your beds and along your paths. But it is not so: there is time for devotion and a time for rest and amusement".

Several new converts to Islam had no home or means of living. They had settled around the mosque near Muhammad's (PBUH) house and came to be known as Ahl As-Suffah or the people of the bench. The Prophet lived modestly, often he had just a few dates left to eat. Yet he kept helping the people of the bench whenever and with whatever he could.

Once a companion had started to say to the Prophet, "If it is the will of God and the will of the Prophet..." The Prophet's face changed colour and he reprimanded, "Are you trying to equate me with God? Rather say: If God, alone, wills". In this context, one of the Prophet's famous sayings is, "Woe unto them that they turned the graves of their prophets into tabernacle; do not turn my grave into a place of worship".

Contrary to popular belief. that was generally propagated by the Western Orientalists, the Quran has more often taken the side of women in matters of disputes related to practices of divorce, inheritance, and freedom of expression. Within the Prophet's mosque in Medina, the women would stand behind the men's rows, as the postures of prayers in various stages required an arrangement that preserves the modesty of women. The back rows for the women were not due to any kind of inferior ranking. In such an arrangement Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) had ruled that the men should remain seated after the prayers while the women left first without any inconvenience.

The Quran gives a common order to serve the needy, the destitute, the handicapped, the orphan without any differences and distinctions, and irrespective of caste, class, and nationality. This command finds expression in Muhammad's sayings:

'God is not merciful to a person who is not merciful towards others'.

'Rahman, the Merciful showers mercy on those who are merciful. Be merciful to the people of this earth, He will be merciful on you'.

'You would never be a person of faith unless you are merciful'.

'The best among you is the one from whom people expect only good, and are safe from his wickedness. The evil amongst you is the one from whom people do not expect any good, and are not safe from his wickedness'.

Gentleness and kindness took the topmost ranking in the Prophet's sayings:

'God is gentle and he loves gentleness in everything'.

'There are two qualities in you that God loves: nobleness and tolerance'.

Once a Bedouin boy urinated on the mosque's wall. The Muslims who saw him doing that rushed to beat him. But the Prophet intervened to save the culprit. Then he poured water over the place to clean it, and he explained to the Bedouin that as it was a place of worship it was not expected of anyone to filthy it, and he let the Bedouin go. After he went, the Prophet said to his people, "You have been sent to make things easy (for the people) and you have not been sent to make things difficult for them".

Almighty God says in the Quran, "Nor walk on the earth with arrogance; for you cannot break it open nor can you match the mountains in height". (Q: 17: 37)

And Prophet Muhammad (Peace be upon him) said, "Humility and courtesy are themselves ways of reverencing God".

On another occasion he had exclaimed thrice in a row, "Woe to those who exaggerate (do excess)", and he had also said: Moderation, moderation! For only with moderation will you succeed.

In the social and political dimensions, the Prophet sought the advice of his companions and encouraged them to express their opinions. He had evolved a genuine pedagogy and through that he allowed the Muslims to develop their critical faculties and talents. Often he would ask questions on various subjects and give his answer after others had expressed their replies. In this context, he once said, "A strong man is not a man who overcomes his enemy."

The companions thought over this and asked, "Then who is a strong man?"

He replied, "A strong man is a man who controls himself when he is angry".

Another time he spoke figuratively, "Wealth does not lie in the riches you possess".

While the listeners were pondering, he elaborated, "True wealth is the wealth of the soul".

Another of his statements was: "Help your brother, whether he is just or unjust".

The companions were thinking how that could be. Then the Prophet added: "Prevent him (the unjust brother) from acting unjustly; such is the way for you to help him".

In other matters, too, Muhammad (PBUH) brought in dramatic changes. He recognised that though the sword cannot take the place of reason or justice, there could be some occasions when it would be a duty to unsheathe it- when liberty is trampled; when freedom is at stake; when justice becomes a mockery; and hirelings occupy the seats of authority. A Muslim may also use it in self-defence, provided he sheathes it again when there is an inclination towards peace by the rival. He is further allowed the use of the sword to establish freedom of conscience, irrespective of faith even if the persecutor happens to be a Muslim. There is nothing in the Quran, nor in the words of the Prophet that authorises the propagation of the faith by the use of the sword; any such propagation is unlawful in Islamic law. Equally, nothing authorises wars of aggression. The Quran categorically states, 'let there be no compulsion in religion. (Q: 2:256).


It further says, "Say, People of the Book, let us arrive at a statement that is common to all" - (Q: 3:64).

Muhammad rendered the existing system of clergy obsolete as he restored God and man to their proper position just as the Creator had intended. Even as the Prophet did not undertake to intercede for anyone, he made God accessible to the multitudes without intercession. The catalogue of multitudes of sins was reduced by Islam to a bare minimum- no ascetic penance, no abrogation of human faculties. Muhammad was not only a warner, he was also a bearer of glad tidings. "Eat of the good things of life," said he, "and render thanks to Allah'. In this refrain, he also said, "O you who believe, spend of the good things you have earned, and all that which is brought forth from the earth".

The emancipation of women introduced by the Prophet was far-reaching. The notion of the original sin was consigned to the flames. According to Islam, every child, whether a boy or a girl, is born sinless. No longer was it necessary to regard woman as a product of the devil; no longer was it axiomatic that woman was made for man and not man for woman. To the Jews who tell their women, 'thy desire is for thy husband and he shall rule over thee, Islam replies, 'woman is the sovereign of your house; she has like rights as those of man, the same is due to her as is due from her'.

As Islam spread and the empires of Muslims extended, the local inhabitants experienced the kindheartedness and the favours done on them and entered into its fold. They were not forced by anyone to do so. They were allowed to practice their faith because the Quranic injunction was 'there is no compulsion in religion. As the Muslims came into contact with other societies, they too got influenced in some ways by the reforms brought about by the Prophet of Islam. And so, his coming into the world was a mercy not only for the Muslims but to mankind too. The Prophet left the heads of states of Arabia in their seats of power, leaving their economies and political structures untouched. If Islam spread it was simply because it was strong by virtue of the truth it proclaimed, and the trait of indiscrimination between Arab and non-Arab that it followed, and the strict monotheism of Islam enabled man to have no master except the one true God. Towards the end of Muhammad's (PBUH) life, the entire peninsula was truly a league of Islamic-Arab nations. They acted together as one man against those who opposed. Their cities were capitals of science, knowledge, and industry. In the words of Muhammad Husayn Haykal, " This felicity continued until the Muslims changed their view of Islam, denied its noble principles, violated the brotherhood of the faithful, and forgot that man's faith is never complete until he has desired for his fellow man what he desires for himself. It was then that prejudice did its evil work and destructive contests for power tore up the Muslim brotherhood". Muslims need to ponder on Haykal's words that unfold how they lost their glory.


On November 2, 2021, IMPAR wished for prosperity and happiness on the auspicious occasion of Dhanteras.

Other than this, the District Councils may organise some activity on this line. Your suggestions and advice are solicited".


