#### EXTRAORDINARY TIMES REQUIRE EXTRAORDINARY RESPONSE



April 10, 2022, Today marks the completion of IMPAR's two years of existence. The journey has been both exciting and eventful. A lot has been done and a lot is yet to be achieved. Today the country is passing through unprecedented times. The huge diversity of India also presents a unique opportunity. However, there is also a dichotomy to deal with. While the social environment is touching a new low with increasing gulf among communities and a threatening communal situation, the economic environment on the other hand seems to be creating business, trade, and investment opportunities like never before with the economic growth and exports touching an all-time high. India, riding on the wave of start-ups is all set to churn out 50 unicorns in 2022 from previous year of 36. The youngsters are becoming billionaires in no time. But, where Indian Muslims as a community stand today is a matter of concern for IMPAR. And it wishes to draw the attention of the community members to the challenges and reality of the times and expects a sincere introspection so as to devise workable plans to work on the same with a sense of urgency. IMPAR called an emergency meeting yesterday to discuss the developing situation and make plans for immediate action. However, as usual, there were few good recommendations, with the customary approach of long speeches and hyperbole dominating. The time for such emotional speeches and cursing others is now over. It has not worked in the past. It will not work in the future too. We also need to come out of the binary of secular and communal, otherwise we head nowhere. We must understand the design of the inimical forces and must have plans and courage to act and defeat. It's time to think innovatively and out of the box to weaken or moderate the forces of communalism, and not strengthen them in the name of fighting them, an art we have traditionally mastered through tear shedding speeches and parading the community on emotional platforms. This may have served the interests of few petty politicians and members of the clergy, but surely pushed the community to where it finds today. In the last eighteen years, since I have been involved in the Muslims policy affairs, my consistent observation is that we, as a community have no political vision. And the social and political analysis by our learned community members completely lacks objectivity. In the name of our political vision, we only wish to get an MLA ticket and defeat a political party. It's time to depart and work for what works for us, and not what pleases our prejudiced thoughts conditioned by interest serving speech mafia constituency. It's time to speak out. Politically, in the name of defeating BJP we have brought BJP to where it is today. The more we defeat BJP the more it wins. Have we ever

thought what the net result of our clarion calls has been? We have created a situation of political optionlessness today. BJP is no longer interested in us, and seculars fear talking about us. Muslims aggressively opposing BJP best works for it politically. But is this what we want, and have we ever learnt from the experiences? Our consistent refusal to read the bold writings on the wall has proven quite detrimental. The Babri Masjid case and the price community paid for BMAC role for 30 years action is a classic example. There also exists a constituency of fear marketers and doomsday theory propagators, who are only creating more fear, negativity, and regression. Forwarding unverified whatsapp videos is their usual business, never bothering about the fruitless exercise and the negative impact it creates on the young minds. I could never understand if our intellectuals fail to understand this simple logic or do they themselves always fall for those emotional speeches and rhetoric? Could we not learn from how Jews in US and Patels in Gujarat move politically? And how Jats in Haryana paid the price twice for acting politically the way we always acted? The Jats in Western UP learnt from them and acted wisely. So did the Yadays. But, we continue to relentlessly carry that contract of defeating BJP as the only aim of our existence. And now paying the price. We choose to stand behind weak, corrupt and castiest leaders, who go in hibernation, when we need them. And by our misplaced political aggression we only invite wrath of the society. Painfully for me, for the follies of 5% intellectual Muslims, who are prisoners of their thoughts, the price is paid by 95% poor fellows on the ground. Should we not, at least, be ashamed of what we are doing to the poor chaps on the ground? We as a community needed to establish credible think tanks and action groups at the State and district levels, but could not do even at the national level, which could deliberate on challenges and strategic issues and do fact based advocacy? When IMPAR was created as an emergency response system to deal with the Corona Jihad, and we were working in emergency mode, day and night to deal with the crisis, Muslim intellectuals grouped up worldwide to spread all sort of fake stories against IMPAR. We have not learnt from the past experiences or the life of visionaries such as Mir Salar Jung or Sir Syed. Anyway, the question before the community today is not about the follies or farsightedness of any individual or organisation but, how do we deal with and try to avert a crisis situation appear brewing, as the reports of increased communal incidents flowing in from different parts, from vandalising religious places to giving calls of businesses boycotts. In such trying times the question before us, is if we watch over the situation and pray that with time it subsides and sense prevails or work out a response system, be it social outreach, legal actions, media and political engagement or governmental interventions? Can we have a group of people, who do not wish to seek personal favours, to sincerely engage with RSS, and to whom community does not term as traitors? In my understanding a fair assessment of the ground reality is required. Is this spontaneous or planned and is this one sided or are we also responsible in some way? Can we do our part of lighting the lamp by overdue reforms? While punitive actions are required as deterrent in some cases, but in long run we have to create understanding and respect in the society for goodwill and peace. Today perception about Muslims in general is very poor. If the general opinion of people about Muslims is negative, nothing can possibly work positively. We need to learn from Sikhs, how they changed the perceptions after 1984, by creating Khalsa Aid and serving the humanity to earn the respect of the society. Nothing will function better or last longer than societal respect. While IMPAR considers political and legal options in cases of communal acts or vandalism, I am certain that the majority community's goodwill is the best long-term safeguard for minorities in India and across the globe.

#### **MEETINGS:**

#### IMPAR held a Meeting to discuss emerging situation unfolding in the country

10<sup>th</sup> April 2022, A meeting was held by IMPAR to discuss the challenges faced by the community on the increasing communal incidents continuously happening in a number of states. The remedial steps were discussed that need to be taken to prevent the situation from turning bad to worse. During discussion the speakers were of the opinion that these incidents are an attempt to disturb the atmosphere of communal harmony and peace either by anti-social elements or by the fringe right wing group with or without the tacit approval of police and local administration.

It was discussed that for tackling the situation we should engage with the constitutional authorities. Besides this we may give memorandum to Central as well as state govts for stopping this menace sooner than later. We may form a legal cell to file cases in the courts under whose jurisdiction an incident comes.

Other speakers advocated to file case locally wherever the incident takes place. The speakers further insisted on responding suitably to the provocative news appearing every other day on SM. It was agreed unanimously that the program should be intensified of voter registration of the citizens in the electoral roll of India.

At the end it was discussed that personal meetings with Ministers and senior officials in Government officials shall certainly work as a deterrent in the future mishaps. A suggestion also came that wherever required the option of sit-in near Gandhi Pratima shouldn't be ruled out.

Shri Javed, Dr. Anis Ansari, Mr. Syed Rizwan, Mr. Musharraf Ali, Col. Zahid Siddiqui, Mr. Najmuddin A Farooqi, Mr. Irshad Ahmad, Dr. Tajwar, Mr. Ahmed Shujauddin, Mr S Ahmad Abdullah, Mr. Shahzad Khan, Mr. Yusuf Ansari and Sabiha Hassan expressed their views. The Chairman IMPAR, Dr M.J. Khan listening to the views of speakers, assured them for meeting the Higher Authorities in this regard and shall communicate the feelings of well-meaning people in the society. The program was conducted by Mr. Khalid Ansari E.D IMPAR.

Dr. M. J. Khan, Chairman of IMPAR, Mr. Shams Khwaja Advocate, Ms. Amina Sherwani, Kashif Rizvi Advocate, Ms. Sitwat Nabi Advocate, Dr. Tajwar Khan, Sajid Khan, and Mr Khalid Ansari, Executive Director of IMPAR, attended the meeting. It was decided at the meeting to send a five-member fact-finding team to Khargone and later file a petition in the Court of Law. IMPAR had also written to the Prime Minister, drawing attention to rising intolerance and violence by Hindu groups against Muslims and urging him to take immediate action.

20th April IMPAR organised a brainstorming session today at India Islamic Centre in New Delhi on dealing with the current prevailing situation and devising long term strategic plans to bring about positive sustainable change. The meeting deliberated upon the current challenges and analysed the social and political trends to assess the emerging challenges and emphasised on working out the workable solutions. Creating better understanding through dialogues, higher level of political engagements, goodwill through increased social work, initiating reforms, countering narratives through data, use of social media, creating emergency response system, including legal response, use of digital tools for protection. The emphasis was on creating better understanding through interfaith dialogues and addressing trust deficit due to certain misunderstandings. The meeting was attended by 20 eminent persons.

#### **International Earth Day activities**



## IMPAR Survey on incident of communal violence and an anti-encroachment drive at Jahangirpuri (C-block)

22/23 April 2022, The IMPAR team carried out a survey to know about the ground reality following an incident of communal violence and an antiencroachment drive at Jahangirpuri (C-block). According to the results of the survey, many families have lost their assets, have lost their only source of income, and they require immediate assistance with rationing as well as rehabilitation. A fund-raising campaign was also launched in order to offer urgent food/rations, necessary legal assistance, livelihood assistance, and fair recompense so that victims may return to work.



#### COMMUNICATION WITH THE GOVERNMENT AGENCIES /ORGANIZATION

On behalf of NRIs in Saudi Arabia, an IMPAR request to the HRD Minister about the inclusion of a NEET Centre in Riyadh was successfully granted.

Dr MJ Khan, president of IMPAR shared the small success of IMPAR in pursuing with the Government the request of NRIs in Saudi Arabia for a NEET Centre in Riyadh. After getting the details from Indian Forum in Riyadh, IMPAR took the matter up with the HRD Ministry, but realising the challenge of time in getting it done through normal processes, a request was made directly to the HRD Minister, who was considerate to appreciate the enormity of challenge over two million Indians in Saudi facing. Finally, the case was processed with expediency and the Riyadh Center approved. Thanks to the Riyadh Forum for initiating and a big thanks to the Minister for his extraordinary support. Huge relief to 2.6 million Indians in KSA. Learning from the experience, he wished to accelerate efforts on policy research and advocacy, along with the economic empowerment and community reforms agenda. He added that IMPAR Will soon share the agenda details for wider consultation before finalising the plan of action.


### IMPAR Advisory on Religious Processions 25th April 2022

We are aware of the spate of violence in the recent weeks in different parts of the country during the Ram Navmi processions and prevailing communal situation. As the fact-finding reports are coming, post violence, it becomes increasingly clear that vested interests are at work to create violence. Based on the ground reports and consultations with the experts, IMPAR is pleased to issue following Do's and Don'ts Advisory for the Community to follow during any processions:

- **1.** Form a 10 member Mohalla committee in case of bigger municipal corporation cities and 25-member city committee in case of smaller municipality level cities. The committee may comprise prominent advocates, journalists, social workers, retired government officers, members of clergy etc.
- 2. The number may vary based on local assessment. This may include some members of other communities too, and also meetings may be done with prominent members, and social and religious organisations of other faiths.
- **3.** Compile and circulate mobile numbers of police and administrative officials, which are easily available, including the local inspectors, CO, ACP, DM and SP numbers.
- **4.** The committee should meet the local police and give its letter for adequate police deployment along the route and discuss other necessary preventive measures to be taken by police. Higher authorities may also be given written requests.
- **5.** Put up welcome banners along the route for the processions and wherever possible offer them water and sharbat etc. and put-up flower petals.
- **6.** Put up cameras on the religious places along the route. In fact, such cameras should permanently be put up outside and inside religious places and other important community buildings.
- 7. Completing documentation and keeping necessary papers of properties, and insurance of business and factories and other such assets of commercial importance must be done so as to claim cover in case of any unfortunate incidents.
- **8.** Facebook live must be done from different houses and for that youths may be trained. This will be irrefutable record and evidence; in case any unfortunate incidents happen.
- **9.** In case of the provocative slogans the community members must try to keep patience and not respond to the designed provocations. In case situation becomes intolerable, police may be requested, and instant SOS messaging can be done to higher officials
- **10.** Must stay away from any stone pelting or any such reactions, no matter what the provocation, as majority communalism can not be responded to by minority communalism. Better to keep patience and take help of police and saner voices.
- **11.** In case of any unfortunate incident, community members must do thorough assessment of the damage and fact finding of the incident and based on that an objective report to be prepared. The same may be released to the media and circulated on social media for subsequent legal and other actions. All efforts should be focussed on maintaining peace through meetings and dialogues with police and peace committees, prominent citizens and social and cultural organisations. The above steps, more of preventive in nature, are required to check any such trouble from arising.

#### **IMPAR Eid-Ul-Fitr Guidelines**

- Avoid offering Namaaz on roads. By occupying public spaces, we are violating passengers' rights and
  causing inconvenience to others. If the number of people is large, having multiple Jamaats is a better
  alternative.
- Parking should be done in reserve areas or on the road but in a way that it does not cause any inconvenience. Masjids and Eidgah can have groups of volunteers for parking management. If the distance is short, it is preferable to avoid driving and instead take public transportation.
- Co-operate with the police and local administration for better crowd management at Eidgahs and Masjids, where Eid prayers are planned. In case of difficulty anticipated, requests can be made to the local police station for additional force.
- Soften the loudspeaker sounds for Azaan and Khutba to avoid inconvenience to public. The Namaaz timings can be communicated in advance through previous day prayers or printing of leaflets.
- Volunteers can be deployed, or a camera person hired for live recording of the crowd management and prayers at Eidgah and Masjids. Should the necessity arise, the recording can be kept for a few weeks.
- Invite your friends and neighbors regardless of faith to celebrate together, share the happiness, spread harmony, and add more charm to the day. This is keeping in view the Eid spirit of spreading love, care and brotherhood.
- After the prayers, proper cleaning of the surrounding areas must be done, as lots of food is littered and vendors normally go away without cleaning. Maintaining cleanliness via extra effort on this day would add to the beauty of Eid.
- Make proper arrangements for drinking water and sharbat at all the sites of prayers for the common man passing through those areas. Offering sweets will be a good idea indeed.
- Identify the volunteers and issue identity cards to them, to look after the management of the prayer sites and other necessary work, including offering sweats and cleaning. Let us add more value to the day. This is a day when kids participate in celebrations in large numbers, give them a good and inspiring message, distribute toys, stationery, and good books after Namaaz. Inspire and engage them in social work. Together we can build a healthy society based on trust, love and compassion

### A Press Release on country's continuing communal disturbances 11 April 2022

IMPAR is deeply concerned about the country's continuing communal disturbances. These incidents are attempts by antisocial elements or a fringe right-wing group, with or without the tacit support of the police and local administration, to disrupt the atmosphere of communal harmony and peace in the country. We have been attempting to advocate and steer the community towards progress, believing that it can only be paved by laying down the bricks of a strong foundation of brotherhood and peace whereas a pessimistic approach, hatred and violence will only tear India's communal fabric. The rhetoric of unrest in the country could be the result of frequently repeated diatribes by fringe groups, which easily serve to smear a particular community. However, we must make sure not to view humanity and brotherhood through the lens of division or politics. During outbreaks of violence, we recommend filing a case locally, wherever the incident occurs and responding suitably and responsibly to the provocative news that appears on social media every other day. To secure our Nation's diversity and inclusiveness, we urge all Indians, particularly the Muslim community, to stand together in communion with other communities and not be influenced by any form of anger or resentment, which could exacerbate an already distressing situation.

### Press Release on the communal conflicts and the Vision of India 2030 17 April 2022

IMPAR has today written to the Hon'ble Prime Minister about the disturbed communal situation in the country, expressing its deep concerns, and seeking time for a 10-member delegation to meet and apprise the PM of the community's concerns. IMPAR applauds the PM for his visionary leadership in a rapidly growing economy, and also expanding its diplomatic influence with well-crafted stand on key global issues. The country of 140 crore population is rapidly marching to the place in the comity of nations that it deserves. The people of Indian origin are also making a deep mark worldwide through their contributions in the field of science, technology, finance and businesses. As a result, the change in perception about India and Indians is quite visible, and citizens of a large number of countries look up to us with awe and hope, said IMPAR president, Dr. MJ Khan. Under the PM's Vision for India of Tomorrow, through the agenda of development and governance, and global cooperation, it has given new confidence and everyone seems onboard to deliver, asserts the IMPAR letter, adding that in a hugely vast and socially diverse country, the challenges will always remain. Who are these elements, who are working against the interest of the nation and disrupting the agenda of development and governance, asked IMPAR? Peace and justice in the society is prerequisite to development. IMPAR stands with the Government and the nation in promoting understanding for peace and prosperity in the society, said Dr. Khan.

चर्चा में जहां अधिकांश वक्ताओं का मत था कि ये घटनाएं आगामी चुनाव की तैयारी के तहत ध्रुवीकरण का माहौल बनाने का प्रयास है और एक तिहाई जनाधार की पार्टी संविधान में एतबार न करके अपने एजेंडे पर काम कर रही है इससे निपटने के लिए हमें शेष संविधान पोषकों को ,जो अभी बिखरा हुआ है , के साथ मिलकर काम करना चाहिए और हमारी कौम को राजनीतिक क्षेत्र में आगे बढ़ना चाहिए ।मतदाता सूचियों में अपने क्षेत्र के मतदाताओं के नाम जुड़वाना सुनिश्चित करना चाहिए ।

इसके अतिरिक्त सरकार के विभिन्न स्तरों पर कौम के साथ हो रही घटनाओं को रोकने के लिए ज्ञापन देने , उपयुक्त स्थलों पर प्रदर्शन करने पर भी विचार करना चाहिए तथा लीगल सेल स्थापित कर प्रभावित लोगों को न्याय दिलवाने में सहायता देने में आगे आना चाहिए ।वहीं कुछ वक्ताओं ने किसी एक क्षेत्र में हुई घटना को उसी क्षेत्र में सरकारी या विधिक सहायता से निपटाने की वकालत की।

और सोशल मीडिया की भड़काने वाली खबरों की सच्चाई जान कर उस पर प्रतिक्रिया देने पर जोर दिया । कार्यक्रम के अंत में इन घटनाओं को रोकने के लिए संस्था या व्यक्तिगत तौर पर मंत्रियों व उच्चाधिकारियों से मिलकर इस पर अपना विरोध तो दर्ज करवाने पर जोर दिया तािक भविष्य में सनद रहे। यदि इस पर कोई कार्रवाई न होती दिखे तब प्रदर्शन का भी सहारा लिया जाए ।

कार्यक्रम में श्री जावेद , डाॅ. अनीस अंसारी , श्री सैयद रिजवान, श्री मुशर्रफ अली ,कर्नल जाहिद सिद्दीकी, श्री नजमूद्दीन फारूकी , श्री इरशाद अहमद , डाॅ. ताजवर ,श्री अहमद शुजाउद्दीन ,सैयद अहमद अब्दुल्ला, श्री शहजाद खान, श्री युसुफ अंसारी व सबीहा हसन ने अपने विचार रखे।

### Tribute to the martyrs of the Jallianwala Bagh massacre


13th April 2022, IMPAR pays homage to the martyrs of the Jallianwala Bagh massacre that took place on April 13, 1919. On the afternoon of April 13, a crowd of men, women, and children had peacefully gathered to protest at Jallianwala Bagh, which was almost surrounded by walls and had only one exit. The demonstration was held to protest the arrest of freedom fighters Satya Pal and Dr Saifuddin Kitchlew, who were a symbol of Hindu-Muslim unity. When Colonel Reginald Dyer came to know about the gathering, he arrived at the location with a contingent of 50 soldiers and ordered them to open fire on those who had gathered. The firing lasted about 10 minutes and resulted in approximately 1,650 rounds of bullets being fired; the volley of bullets stopped only when the soldiers ran out of ammunition. In this indiscriminate shooting, more than 379 people were killed, and 1,200 were injured.



May this Baisakhi generate new opportunities, immense joy, peace and happiness for the country.



1<sup>st</sup> May 2022, IMPAR celebrates the daily efforts of workers who strive to make our country a better place!




#### IMPAR extended greetings on Eid-ul-Fitr


