About IMPAR



IMPAR was created on April 10, 2020, as an emergency response to the targeted media trial of the community in the name of Corona Jihad during the Covid19 lockdown period that had created a very difficult situation. IMPAR brought under one platform over 500 prominent Muslims to articulate the community response and engage with the media, the government, and other key stakeholders to bring about a change in the prevailing situation. IMPAR, thereafter, functioned as a national think tank to achieve internal changes with a modern perspective, and effectively carved a new course for the community to follow in terms of advancement and reforms in a short period of two years. Today, IMPAR has over 10,000 members, including over 300 globally, and have created units in 40 districts and 11 States. It has initiated a series of social programs and campaigns, including sanitation drive, documentation drive, business support program, employment generation, policy and economic research, communication with key stakeholders, and awareness programs to educate and empower the community besides engagement and public advocacy.

VISION

To change the image and perception of Indian Muslims through proactive policy and media engagements, the initiatives of positive social actions, the cultivation of leadership opportunities for women and young people, and the facilitation of access to quality education and economic opportunities.

MISSION

To act as a think-tank, watchdog, research centre advocacy and communication group for Indian Muslims, dedicated to fostering better understanding between different communities across the country by meaningfully engaging with key stakeholders e.g. government, media, policymakers, business and political organisations. We also work to promote education and awareness of key issues, inculcating among the community, especially in youth, the national ethos, shared culture, adoption of rational thinking and scientific temperament for accomplishing necessary reforms.

MESSAGE

As IMPAR completes its two-year journey since its creation on April 10, 2020, we would like to present this booklet of Significant Achievements for the year 2021-22, which compiles IMPAR's efforts.

This report provides a concise overview of the IMPAR's deliberations and initiatives during the previous two years, working as an apex think-tank for Indian Muslims and sharing programmatic information with the single-minded goal of addressing and resolving community concerns at the top of its developmental agenda.

This booklet aims to further inform the public and IMPAR members on the progress being achieved and to encourage their participation in serving the community.

We hope that this annual report will be useful for a quick reference to know about the wide range of work that IMPAR takes up to bring about a positive change in the society.

OUR WORK OVERVIEW: HIGHLIGHTS OF THE YEAR 2021-2022

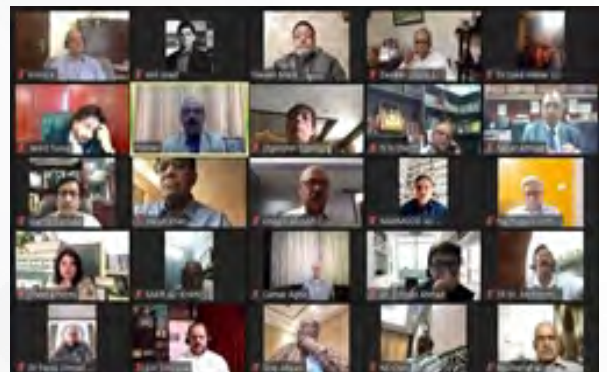
MEETINGS :

- Meeting of the **IMPAR Steering Committee** was held to discuss what led to the formation of IMPAR. The members also discussed the factors, progress and success so far and the agenda for the future was deliberated upon.



- IMPAR celebrated its first foundation day on Saturday April 10, 2021 via Zoom. It was attended by IMPAR members from all across India and abroad. Mr. Nawab Malik, Cabinet Minister of Maharashtra, was the Guest of Honour during the Inaugural session. He

applauded IMPAR's outreach and engagement initiatives throughout the first year and provided valuable recommendations for IMPAR's future course of action. The Valedictory session was presided over by Mr. Suresh Prabhu, MP, and PM's Sherpa for G20 nations



- Meeting of the IMPAR Advisory Group on July 6, 2021, at the conference room of the India Islamic Cultural Centre (IICC) in New Delhi. The meeting was

presided by Mr. Najeeb Jung former Lt. Governor Delhi. Mr Jung took stock of the situation and debated on IMPAR's future working agenda.



- IMPAR Bareilly District Council (IDC) Meeting was held On July 8, 2021, the District Council of Bareilly convened a meeting for Eid-ul-Adha sanitation under the supervision of IMPAR Regional Coordinator Mr Sajid Khan. During the conference, two to three key locations in each Mohalla or Colony were selected for animal sacrifice and for the provision of waste disposal.



- On July 29, 2021, IMPAR Delegation met I G Prison Lucknow and discussed with him the legal obligation

for the release of pregnant women and elderly prisoners languishing in various jails in UP. Mr. Anand Kumar, IG Prisons, lauded IMPAR's effort. IMPAR was represented by Mohd Shameem, Sheeba Mushahid and Sabiha Ahmad.



- A Meeting was held on August 11, 2021, on Muslim Development Agenda wherein various issues were discussed and the following agendas for IMPAR were put forward.
 - Digitalization
 - Discover chances in New Education Policies.
 - Coaching and motivational camps.
 - Employment generation
 - Development of artisan clusters and micro-enterprises
 - Extensive communication and shifting social perceptions about Muslims
 - Assist underprivileged students in maintaining good health and nutrition.

 - Demand for Madrasa Education equivalent degrees.
 - Development of skills and guidance for start-ups.
 - Adequate training for reciting the Azan in Mosques
 - Volunteers' recruitment
 - Women empowerment



- A significant event took place in IMPAR Delhi office when for a meeting they welcomed on Aug 13, 2021, the Hon'ble Members of Parliament Mr Mehboob Ali Kaiser of Khagaria Lok Sabha Bihar and Dr Mohammad Jawed of Kishanganj Lok Sabha Bihar. A wide range of issues were discussed between them and Dr MJ Khan, President IMPAR including economic and employment opportunities.



- A meeting of Dr M J Khan was held with Ms Nirmala Sitharaman, Union Minister of finance at her North Block office in New Delhi on September 9, 2021, and had a detailed discussion on the issues concerning the farmers and the minorities.



- A team led by IMPAR Maharashtra State General Secretary Ms Ashee Nemat author & poet and Ms Farida Thakur Reg Coordinator met **Ms Priya Dutt** Ex MP in Mumbai on Aug 23, 21 the delegation apprised Ms Dutt about the working of IMPAR.

Yesterday on September 23, 2021 (Thursday) IMPAR delegation led by its Convenor Ms Sabiha Ahmad along with Ms Mushahid held a meeting with Mr. Anil Kumar- Additional Secretary, Govt. of UP. The ongoing activities of IMPAR and its relevance were discussed in the meeting, which was appreciated by Mr Anil Kumar.



- Meeting of the IMPAR Team led by Col (Dr) Zahid Ullah Siddiqui, Regional Coordinator IMPAR Kanpur with the Director IIT Kanpur held on Sept 18, 2021. Col Siddiqui delivered a discourse on IMPAR initiatives for integrating Muslims in the mainstream, which was admired by the director.
- Consequent to the formation of the IMPAR Executive Committee the Lucknow City Council organised a Zoom meeting on Jan 20, 2021, to welcome the committee members. The next day Mrs Sabiha Ahmad Secretary Executive Committee hosted a meeting of the members at her residence to discuss the future action plan. In the meeting, the executive members discussed the issues and decided to take them up in the order of priorities.



- Meeting of Mr Roshan Baig, IMPAR Research Group Member with Hon'ble Home Minister Karnataka on February 9, 2022, to discuss the law-and-order situation in Karnataka, particularly the Mandya



incident where a Muslim girl student Muskan was heckled publicly by other students and outsiders. He urged the minister to resolve the issue on priority and to make all efforts to make peace among the citizens.

- On March 11, 2022, a meeting was conducted on the Zoom platform to address the topic: Lessons of Assembly Election Verdict 2022: Challenges and Way Forward, during which the election results were examined, and members deliberated on the future course of action.
- As part of consultation series with prominent Muslims in different cities, across the country on election

verdict 2022: impact and way forward, IMPAR organised an interactive session in Lucknow on March 13, 2022, at Islamic Centre, Eidgah Aishbagh, the meeting was co-chaired by Dr MJ Khan, chairman, IMPAR and Hazrat Maulana Khalid Rasheed Saheb Farangi Mahli. There was general consensus on opening dialogue with government and engagement with all key stakeholders, political education of masses and interfaith programs, and involving the community in social work on a large scale to bring about a perceptible change.

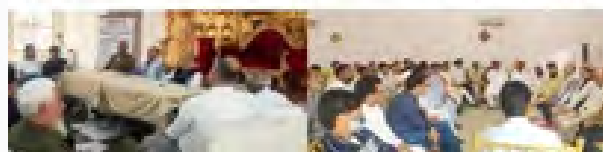
- IMPAR State Council meeting took place on March 17, 2022, in Bhopal, joined by 50 plus prominent Muslims from social, educational and development sectors. Speaking on the occasion, Dr MJ Khan emphasised the need for introspection and coming up with workable solutions for course correction. He asked the members to accelerate documentation work and social work through coordinated actions by NGOs and community institutions. Improving access to government schemes and flagship programs were discussed and an action plan was suggested. The meeting was coordinated by Dr Mehrul Hasan, IMPAR State Coordinator and hosted by Dr Tajwar M. Khan, IMPAR EC member and chairman, KB Nursing College at his house.



- IMPAR district council meetings took place in Meerut on March 15, 2022, and finalised its executive council and strategic work plan. Addressing the meeting, IMPAR president, Dr MJ Khan said the community needs a transformational approach and not transactional while emphasising implementing a 20-year vision plan for the community development. He asked the district executive to form a monitoring and response system for which IMPAR has already issued guidelines. The council took the decision to create volunteers and engage Madrasas to carry out social work and community awareness programs in a mission mode. The meeting was convened by Mr Shoaib Ahmed, DC Meerut and moderated by Mr Khalid Ansari, ED, IMPAR.



- As a part of the community engagement program IMPAR district council meetings took place in Meerut and Hapur on March 19, 2022, and in Bulandshahar and GB Nagar on March 20, 2022, in Western UP, joined by IMPAR president, MJ Khan, SC Member, Justice ZU Khan, and Media Group member, noted journalist, Mr Javed Ansari. In both meetings, about 50 prominent members each participated and shared their views and suggestions. The participants emphasised conducting Outreach programs and awareness drives and creating district-level community monitoring and response systems.
- Continuing with its community engagement programs, IMPAR hosted dialogue sessions in Shamli,

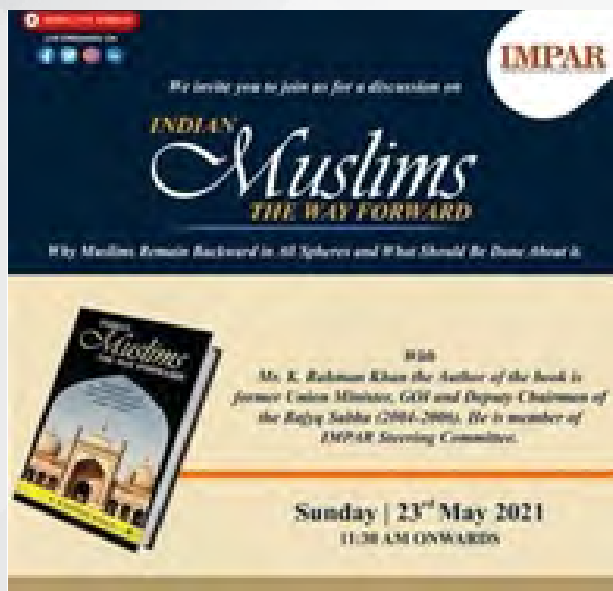

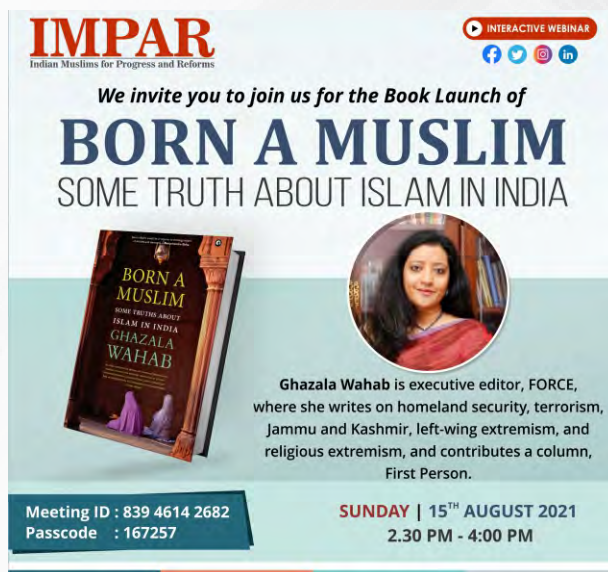


- **Aug 10, 2021-** A webinar was held on religious discrimination under Article 341 (3) and the way forward

- **Dec 31, 2021** - An award ceremony was held by the Consultative Committee of Indian Muslims in North America and IMPAR, the recipients for the scholarship award was announced by Mr Khalid Ansari and certificates were presented to the candidates by Mr Javed Yunus.



- **February 13, 2022** - IMPAR conducted a webinar on National Women's Day which also marked the birth Anniversary of Sarojini Naidu deemed to have fought



tirelessly for women's empowerment in the country. On this occasion, IMPAR discussed the topic: Is the hijab a symbol of oppression or liberation? Where the speakers looked upon the burning issue of Hijab unfolding in the country and discussed Hijab being freedom of choice and a concept rather than a mere piece of cloth. This webinar initiated a critical discussion and the way forward to how to deal with the situation.

- **February 20, 2022** - IMPAR hosted an interactive webinar on World Social Justice Day, where prominent speakers shared their perspectives on the theme "Closing the Inequalities Gap to Achieve Social Justice".

Important Appeals and Advisories Issued

- IMPAR issued the COVID safety guidelines for Ramadan.
- IMPAR issued an appeal for COVID-19 vaccination in which it asked Indian residents to be vaccinated for the virus and to ensure that the COVID-19 vaccine is the only solution that can protect us from the virus's lethal onslaught, which might be dangerous to us.
- Eid-ul-Azha Advisory on July 12, 2021, IMPAR published Eid-ul-Azha Guidelines to maintain safety and avoid the layover of the third wave of Covid-19.
- On the 20th of August 2021, IMPAR issued an advisory to the public to refrain from making any statements about the Taliban.
- IMPAR appeals to voters on 23rd January 2022 keeping in view Assembly Elections in 5 states in February 2022.

5. You may offer "Eid Namaz" with jamat in the homes if you are four plus one Imam. With six extra "takbir". Two attached "khutbat" written in Arabic should be read after the Namaz and with takbir
6. Celebrate the festival of Eid with simplicity with your family staying indoors.
7. Spend on charity instead of shopping. Let us help people and serve humanity.

minimal charge of INR 30. He personally helped some patients in importing oxygen concentrators from London and Germany. Moreover, he worked

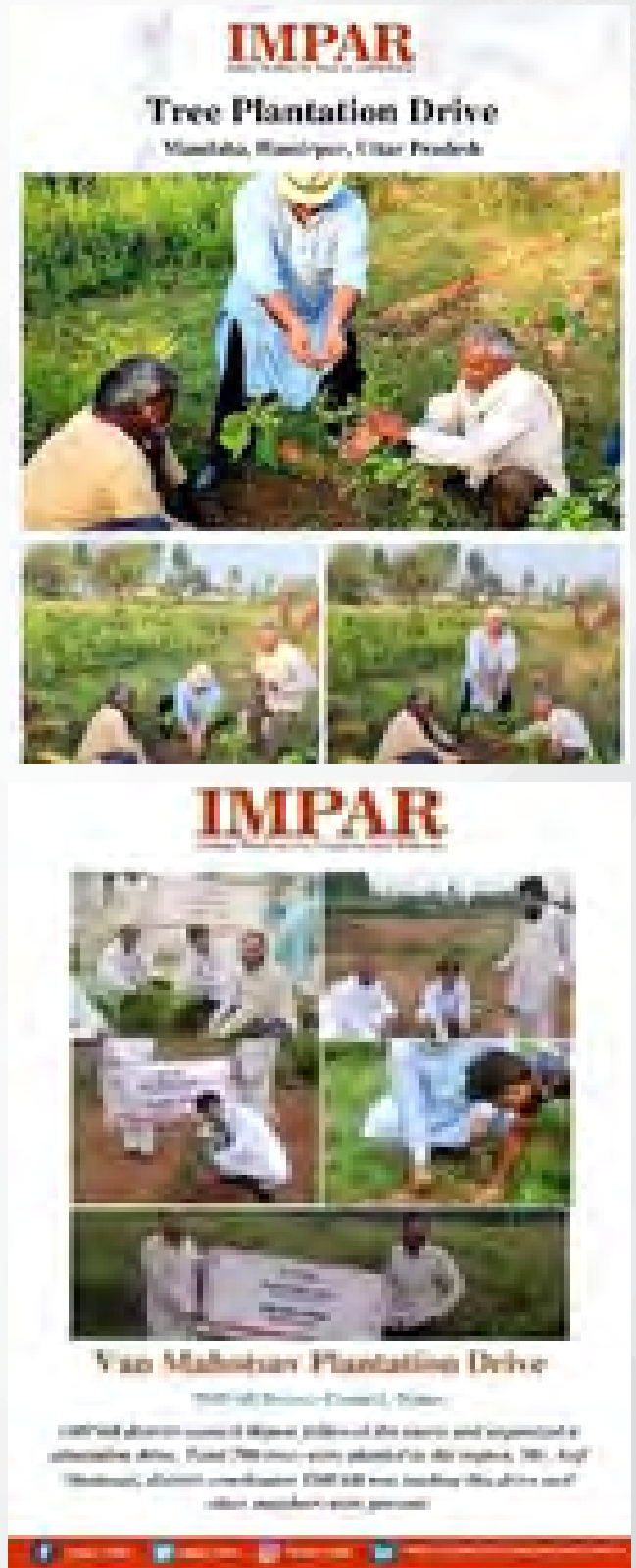

Immediately following the conclusion of the elections, Muslims from around the nation and abroad are invited to gather on a single platform to provide feedback and debate the way forward. IMPAR is attempting to present a model by focusing on districts in Haryana, Rajasthan, and western Uttar Pradesh, which borders Delhi. To bridge the gap, the national president has made every effort to develop a continuous dialogue process between the communities.



IMPAR Outreach to Key Stakeholders

- Letter to the Office of Commissioner of Police, Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh regarding two videos that were widely shared over various social media groups. Wherein, some policemen were mercilessly beating Muslim children, which was quite disturbing. Hence, IMPAR spoke with the Police Commissioner, Varanasi, and sent an email.
- Letter of appreciation to RSS Sangsarchalak (Chief) Dr. Mohan Bhagwat about extensive discussion in media, social media, and among social and political groups in India around the world to decode the meaning and message of RSS Sangsarchalak (Chief) Dr. Mohan Bhagwat's speech on July 5, 2021, at Ghaziabad. Dr Bhagwat emphasised keeping the national interest predominantly on the top of the list and appealed to maintain a cordial and harmonious relationship between Hindus and Muslims.
- IMPAR filed an FIR with the Crime Branch, Delhi Police, National Commission on Minorities, and Delhi Commission on Minorities for Unlawful Gathering and Provocative Speeches against Muslims on August 9, 2021, New Delhi.
- A letter was written to the Education Minister of India, Honourable Mr. Dharmendra Pradhan, requesting him on behalf of the parents of the Indian students for granting them a test centre in Riyadh/Jeddah for the examinations conducted by MoE, India at Saudi Arabia -as over 1000 students are seeking to appear in the tests conducted by the MoE, India-. Given the strategic relations between and RSA, and also the families affected, it is requested to kindly consider this very genuine request.
- An email was sent to the Ministry of Education, Government of India for the withdrawal of the course on Jihadi Violence introduced by Jawaharlal Nehru University, Delhi.
- An email was sent to the Chief Minister and LG of Delhi, wherein, a request has been made to take necessary legal action against the accused and compensation of INR 1 Crore to the victim's (Rabiya Saifi) family members.
- A Letter of appreciation was sent to Honourable Thiru M. K. Stalin, Chief Minister, Tamil Nadu by Mr Akbar Batcha, State Coordinator, Tamil Nadu.
- A Letter was sent to Sh. Manohar Lal-Hon'ble Chief Minister of Haryana by Dr MJ Khan President of IMPAR, irregularities of taxes imposed by HUDA on one of our community members.
- A Letter was sent to Sh. Rakesh Asthana- Commissioner of Police by Dr MJ Khan- President of IMPAR, complaining about police atrocities in Northeast on September 15, 2021,

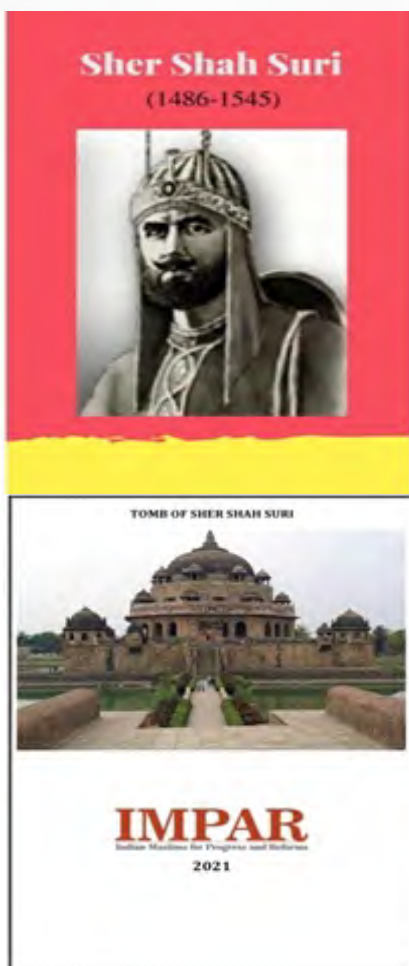

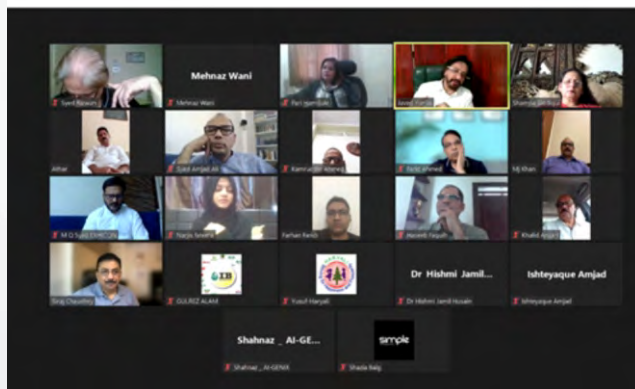


