




# How to report Fake News and Hate Speech on Facebook?



1. Click at the three dots that are there at the top right corner of every post on the Facebook


2. A drop box menu appears on the screen. Like this



*The Picture and the content is hidden to ensure privacy and safety of the user and not to hurt of anyone's sentiments*




# How to report Fake News and Hate Speech on Facebook?



3. Click on Find Support or report post. The moment you click on any option, it gets highlighted in blue colour.



7. Reconfirm the problems you have selected. Facebook also gives option to Block, Unfollow or unfriend the particular user.

8. Click on Report Post. The Post will be submitted for review to the Facebook.

Please note that Facebook keeps on updating its policy and changes are made in the algorithms. A few more confirmatory questions can be asked before you are able to submit the report.
