INDIAN MINORITIES

Social Fabric and Constitutional Provisions


- The Constitution of India uses the word 'minority' or its plural form in some Articles Article 20 to 30 and 350 A to 350 B, but does not define the word 'minority'.
- Article 29 of the Constitution of India has the word 'minorities' in its marginal heading but speaks of "any section of citizens having a distinct language script and culture".
- But the Status has been conferred to various groups. As per clause (c) of Section 2 of the National Commission for Minorities Act, six communities are declared as minority communities are: Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Buddhists, Zoroastrians (Parsis) and Jains.
- According to the Article 29 of the Constitution, any group living within the jurisdiction of India is entitled to preserve and promote its own language, script or literature, and culture.
- Article 36 states that a minority group whether based on religion or language shall have the right to establish and administer educational institution of their choice.
- ☐ Its citizens duty to value and preserve the rich heritage of our composite culture.

- ☐ The Buddhists community have the highest WPR among the minorities (47.22 per cent).
- Among the males, the Sikh men (55.14 per cent) have the highest work participation rate, especially the urban men (55.55 per cent.)
- Buddhist women (40.53 per cent) showed a high WPR among the females, especially the rural women (50.54 per cent). In urban areas, Sikh women have the lowest WPR (15.30 per cent), while it is highest among Parsi women (33.82 per cent).
- ☐ Muslim-OBCs are significantly deprived in comparison to Hindu-OBCs. The work participation rate (WPR) shows the presence of a sharp difference between Hindu-OBCs (67%) and the Muslims. The share of Muslim-OBCs in government/ PSU jobs is much lower than Hindu-OBCs.
- ☐ The presence of Muslims has been found to be only 3% in the IAS, 1.8% in the IFS and 4% in the IPS.
- Muslim community has a representation of only 4.5% in Indian Railways while 98.7% of them are positioned at lower levels. Representation of Muslims is very low in the Universities and in Banks. Their share in police constables is only 6%, in health 4.4%, in transport 6.5%.

Employment Condition of Muslims:

- ☐ Muslims have the lowest share of working people about **33**% among all religious communities in India.
- 11.61 crore Muslims are the part of non-working population.
- Less than **24%** of regular workers from the Muslim community are employed in the public sector or in government jobs.
- Only about 27 per cent of the Muslim workers in urban areas are engaged in regular work while the share of such workers among SCs/STs, OBCs and Hindu UC workers is 40, 36 and 49 per cent respectively
- ☐ Higher presence in 'persons below poverty line'.
- The participation of Muslims in the self-help groups (SHGs) and other micro-credit programs is very limited. The review of government programmes suggests that Muslims have not benefited much from them.

Socio-economic Conditions Of Muzaffarnagar District

- Sex ratio is low in the district (871 per thousand) as compared to the state (898 per thousand).
- ☐ Family size of Muslim households is higher (7.09) than that of other religious groups.
- ☐ Health facilities at sub-centres and PHCs are not as satisfactory as that of private health centres.
- Average expenditure in treatment of diseases is higher in Muslim households i.e. Rs.3091, whereas in Hindu and Sikh households, it is Rs.2807 and Rs.1867, respectively.
- Encouraging trend has been found in dairy related activities (36.67 per cent) than that of other non-agricultural activities like- fishery, manufacturing activities, service activities, etc.
- □ 14. Out of total 30 surveyed villages, it has been found that in 23 villages (76.67 per cent), people are engaged in artisan/handicraft activities. However, it has been reported that training, credit and other facilities are almost non-existent, which is a matter of serious concern.

Socio-economic Conditions Of Muzaffarnagar District

- Due to poor living condition, the average longevity of life among Muslims is shorter than that of other religious groups.
 Most of the rural population lives below the poverty line.
- Most of the rural population lives below the poverty line.
- ☐ 71.11 per cent surveyed households are landless in the district, in which the proportion of Muslims is higher (81.84 per cent) than that of Hindus (65.84 per cent). Average land holding of Muslims has been found low as compared to Hindus and Sikhs.
- □ The unemployment proportion is higher in Muslims i.e. 0.27 per cent than that of Hindus, which is 0.22 per cent. Average income is higher among Sikhs (Rs.64919) and least among Muslims (Rs.37975). In the same way, average expenditure is also higher among Sikhs (Rs.54993) and least among Muslims (Rs.37385).
- ☐ Majority of households have **taken loan from non-institutional sources (78.23 per cent).** Institutional loan is recorded only 21.77 per cent.
- ☐ Improved Electricity Supply is the most important need of the rural areas.
- People give first priority to the dairy related activities (55.60 per cent) Development of dairy cooperative in the area is the need of the hour.
- □ Lack of access to **regular jobs**, especially in the public sector has been a general **concern among the Muslim** population
- ☐ Muslim workers are concentrated in self-employed activities followed by casual labour.

MINORITITES IN POLITICAL SYSTEM

- ☐ Religious minorities other than Muslims find better representation in the Lok Sabha.
- ☐ Sikhs have a representation score of 0.3 percentage points.
- Christians, Buddhists and Jains each have a score of -1 percentage point or less.
- Muslims constitute 14.2 per cent as per the 2011 Census so proportionally speaking they should have had 77 seats in the 16th Lok Sabha. Thus, the under-representation rate stands at a whopping 71.42 per cent for Indian Muslims.

MINORITITES IN PILITICAL SYSTEM

Political Status Of Muslims:

- Muslim's representation in the 16th Lok Sabha has hit an all-time low at 22, while there is none from Uttar Pradesh. This is the worst in the history of Indian Parliament.
- Majority of Muslims remained as landless laborers or engaged in various forms of manual semi-skilled labor.
- Recent actions directed against Muslims have resulted in large-scale destruction of Muslim wealth & business, have further reduced the enthusiasm, security, and confidence that any community requires for economic advancement.
- Lack of appropriate community leadership and the organizational mobilization necessary to bring to light and work to address the social, economical, educational and political marginalization of a large section of the country's Muslims.

MAJOR REASONS FOR INEFFECTIVENESS OF DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS:


- No provision for creating awareness about interventions.
- There is a critical need to address the gap between government schemes and programs and access by the community. The recent report form the Ministry of the Minority affairs reveals that the financial allocations for development minorities have been underutilized. In the 11th National 5 Year Plan the outlay for religious minorities was Rs.1400 crore, but only 35% of the total amount allocated was used.
- Lack of training centres in rural areas.
- Cumbersome application procedures.

THE WAY FORWARD

IMEDA is working towards:

- Setup Imeda coordinator centres at district, block and tehseel levels so that rural (needy) people can get the maximum benefits of the government, schems, and programs.
- Mobilizing and building awareness on minority's rights, welfare programs, skill development programs, employment and other schemes.
- Creating awareness on credit/loan facilities and Subsidies.
- Encourage local artisans, handicraft and household industries among minorities and weaker sections of the society, facilitate training & development programs, and support them in marketing of finished goods using various digital platforms.



SKILLS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS







USTAAD

Scheme aims at upgrading Skills and Training in preservation of traditional Ancestral Arts/Crafts of minorities.

Eligibility:

- The trainee should belong to minority community. In addition, 3% seats will also be reserved for differently abled persons belonging to minority communities.
- The trainee should be between 14-35 years of age. Upper age limit may be relaxed for differently abled persons belonging to minorities.
- The minimum qualification of trainee should be at least Class V. This may also be relaxed for differently abled persons belonging to minorities.
- More than one member of a family is eligible for training in the same art/craft form, provided she/he fulfills the eligibility criteria.

SIKHO OUR KAMAO

Scheme launched by Ministry of Minority Affairs of Central Government but implemented by State Governments. Under this scheme the action is taken against unemployment and unskilled minority population. It is made sure that mass population which is unemployed and with no skills are given training first and then they are introduced to opportunities to earn.

Eligibility:

- Person should be above 18 years of age
- Person should be unemployed
- Person should be from minority community

Document required for the scheme:

- Birth Certificate
- Residence proof (e.g. electricity bill, water bill, gas connection bill)
- Minority community declaration affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper by the student that he/she belongs to any one of the minority communities notified by Central Government
- Education proofs like mark sheets, degrees and certificates (if any)
- Family annual income

PROVISION FOR WOMEN UNDER INTEGRATED SCHEME FOR AGRICULTURE MARKETING

This scheme aims towards promoting creation of agricultural marketing infrastructure by providing backend subsidy support to registered persons and groups including women and SHGs. It promotes creation of scientific storage capacity and to promote pledge financing to increase farmers' income. It provides farmers with access to competitive markets with adequate infrastructure including cold chain logistics, to enable them to realize better prices.

33.33% subsidy (on capital cost) is giving to women as compared to 25% for men. Subsidy ceiling (up to 1000 MT is Rs. 1166.55), more than 1000 MT and up to 30000 MT is Rs. 1000.00, maximum ceiling of Rs 300.00 Lakhs) for women and subsidy ceiling (up to 1000 MT in Rs/MT-875.00, more than 1000MT and upto 30000 MT in Rs/MT -750.00), maximum ceiling (Rs 225.00 Lakhs) for men.


